前言

細則

- 1. 觀察員必須是家教會會員。
- 2. 每次會議最多設兩名觀察員,不一定每次會議都設觀察員。
- 3. 所有會員均可報名,報名名單保密。家教會亦可邀請個別會員成為觀察員。
- 4. 觀察員人選及人數由家教會常務委員會全權決定,不設解釋或申訴程序。
- 5. 觀察員不具投票權或任何法定權力。
- 6. 會議紀錄會列出所有參加會議的觀察員,他們的發言也有可能被記錄在案。
- 7. 會議主席有絕對權力要求觀察員在部分會議環節避席或離開會議。
- 觀察員不得在未經發言者和會議主席的同意下,在會後引述與會者的發言。
- 9. 觀察員身分屬單次性。如欲在另一會議成為觀察員,需再次報名。
- 10. 此安排屬新嘗試。本會將在學年終檢討成效,決定是否優化或延續安排。

報名方法

家教會將在常務委員會會議舉行前約一個月,經班群組及/或Facebook公佈會議日期及時間,同時開放電子表格供會員報名成為觀察員。任何家教會會員均可報名,只需回答簡單問題;家教會亦可能邀請個別會員參加。曾積極參與會務或擔任義工的會員將獲優先分配名額。

在會議舉行前約兩週,家教會將聯絡成功報名人士,確認他(們)的觀察員身分及安排 他們出席會議。

Establishment of an "Observer" system at Parent-Teacher Association meetings

Preface

Our school's Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) elects its Standing Committee every two years. In non-election years, many members have expressed their desire to participate in PTA affairs but are unsure of the ways to do so. Separately, the PTA has always strived to conduct its affairs in an open and transparent manner. Where possible, we hope to encourage active communication and participation from our members to enrich the HKUGAPS community.

As a result, the PTA will introduce an "Observer" system for members to attend our Standing Committee meetings. We hope to increase our transparency as well as to encourage your active participation, especially for members who may be considering running for the PTA Standing Committee in the future.

Guidelines

- 1) Observers must be members of the PTA.
- 2) Up to two observers may attend each meeting though not all meetings will have observers.
- 3) All members are eligible to apply, and the list of applicants will be kept confidential. The PTA may also invite individual members to serve as observers.
- 4) The selection of and number of observers for each meeting will be determined exclusively and in confidence by the PTA's Standing Committee. Its decisions are final and no explanation will be provided.
- 5) Observers do not have voting rights or any statutory authority.
- 6) The meeting minutes will list all observers, and their remarks may be recorded.
- 7) The chairperson of the meeting has absolute authority to require observers to excuse themselves from certain parts of the meeting or to leave altogether.
- 8) Observers may not quote other meeting attendees' statements without prior consent from the speaker and the meeting chairperson.
- 9) Observers serve on a one-time basis, and members must apply separately to be observers for each meeting.
- 10) This system will be implemented on a trial basis and subject to review at the end of this school year.

Application Procedure

The PTA will announce the date and time of its next Standing Committee meeting approximately one month in advance via WhatsApp and/or our Facebook private group. Any member can apply to become an observer by submitting an electronic form and answering a few simple questions. The PTA may also invite individual members. Priority will be given to those who have actively participated in PTA activities and/or served as volunteers.

Approximately two weeks before the meeting, the PTA will contact the successful applicants to arrange their attendance at the meeting.

Due to resource limitations, the PTA may not be able to notify all unsuccessful applicants. We apologize for any inconvenience caused.
